Migration Occupations under the Skilled – Regional Sponsored (475 and 487) visas

The Skilled – Regional Sponsored (475 and 487) visas are available to people with appropriate skills, who wish to live and work in regional Victoria. The Skilled – Regional Sponsored (475 and 487) Eligibility List records the occupations including specialisations, which are currently in demand in regional Victoria, Australia, and are suitable for independent migration.

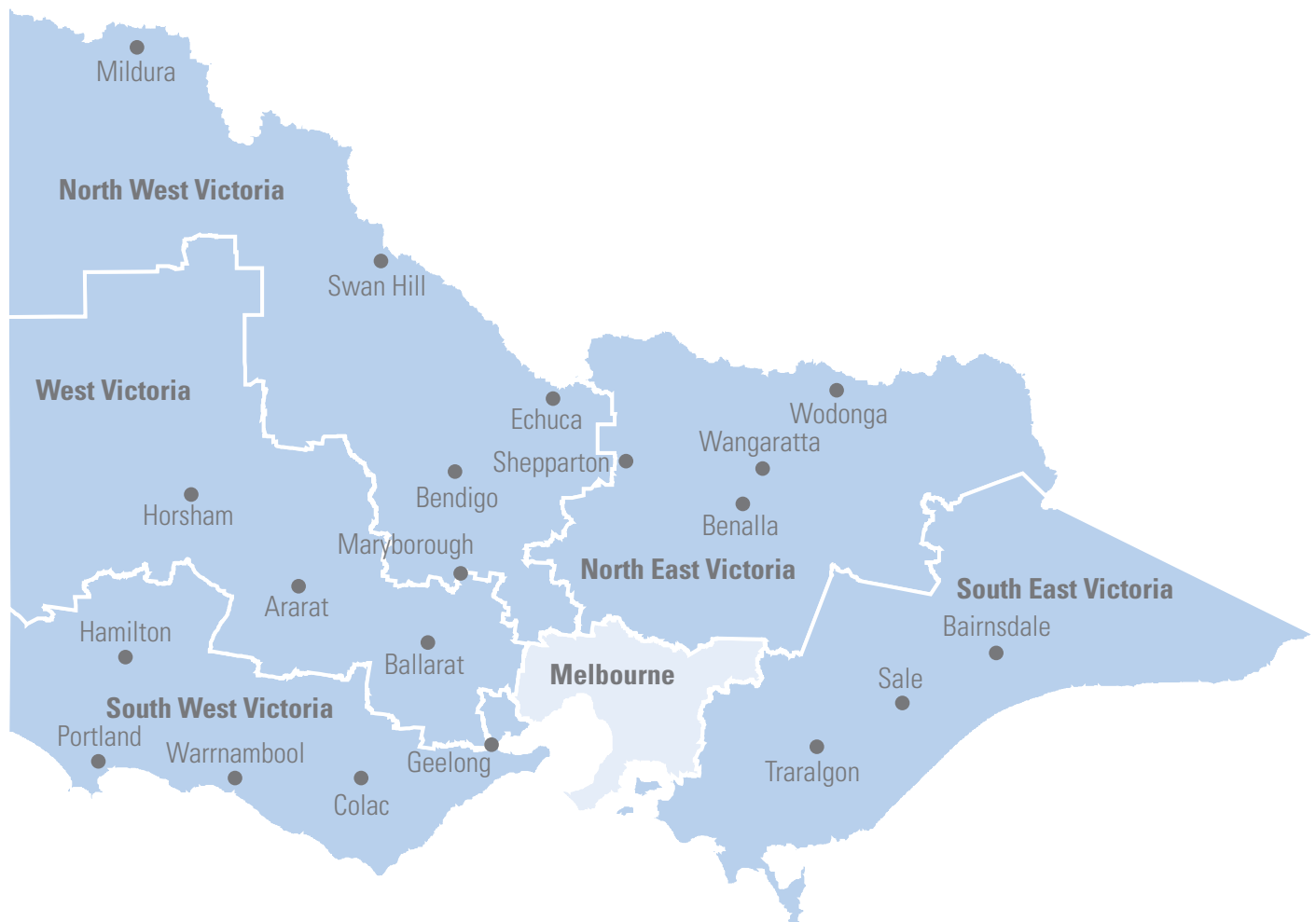
Migration Occupations under the Skilled – Regional Sponsored (475 and 487) Visa

Applications for Victorian Government nomination under the Skilled – Regional Sponsored (475 and 487) visa may be made in one of two ways:

- With an offer of employment, under any occupation on the Skilled Occupation List, or
- With experience in an occupation on the Skilled – Regional Sponsored Eligibility List (no offer of employment required).

Skilled – Regional Sponsored applicants must agree to live in regional Victoria, shaded in the map below.
