



Skilled – Sponsored (886) Eligibility List for Graduates

Migration Occupations under the Skilled – Sponsored (886) visa

The Skilled – Sponsored (886) Eligibility List for Graduates records the occupations for which the Victorian Government will consider applications for visa nomination under the Skilled – Sponsored (886) visa. This list is intended for eligible international students and graduates who want to take advantage of the career and lifestyle opportunities Victoria has to offer. State nomination is a free service and you can stay in Australia while your visa application is being processed.

To be eligible for a Skilled – Sponsored (886) visa, you must hold an eligible student visa and meet the two-year study requirement, or hold a Skilled – Graduate (485) or a Skilled – Recognised Graduate (476) visa. You must also meet the Victorian Government’s eligibility criteria to be considered for visa nomination. A decision about your eligibility for visa nomination by the Victorian Government will be based on the information you provide in your application.
